In Shogi, the winner does not express joy even if they win. When the game is over, both players simply bow their heads. In sports, just like in Shogi, there are cases where players suppress their feelings of joy and just bow their heads quietly to each other.

Sometime ago, when Chiben Wakayama High School won the 2021 Japan Inter-School Baseball Championship, they did not gather to form a circle of joy after clinching victory, but instead immediately lined up. The school captain said, “We thought, we should start and end with a bow and celebrate after it was all over,” showing their respect for their opponents.

We have many opportunities to interact with people on a daily basis and I believe that by treating others with respect and showing gratitude, we can build good relationships.



「Respect for Others」 is the mindset we want to instill our children in school where they learn in groups. To that end, we adults need to listen to what our children have to say and try to analyze their thoughts. Same thing is important in close relationships. For example, within the family, with neighbors, with colleagues, between parents and teachers... by considering the other person's situation and notions, we can foster mutual respect and gratitude. I think the key is to have an open mind. It may not be easy but we must try to consider.
