Infection Measures during School Activities
今後の学校の活動について

Considering that Gifu Prefecture Novel Coronavirus Infection Prevention Committee has announced the “6th Wave - State of Emergency” as of January 17 (Monday), schools will take the following measures.

○Special measures of entire Gifu Prefecture

- Cancellation or postponement of school activities with high infection risk (chorus practice etc.)
 - Cancellation or postponement of activities outside school (visits, travels etc.)
 - Club activities
 - Limited to 2 hours a day, 4 days a week
 - Weekend club activities will be permitted in case of championships only, and will be limited to either Saturday or Sunday (1 day), 3 hours.
 - Practice game will be canceled.
 - In general, clubs will be held within each school (except in case of Official games/championships)
- *The items above also apply to parents club.

○Measures at home

- Do not send the child to school in case any of the following items apply to him/her or a family member
 1. Fever – Siblings can attend school from the next day following the day the child`s symptoms subsided. However, the child should stay at home for a certain period of time (2~3 days or doctor`s recommendation) after his/her symptoms subsided. (It will be considered as attendance suspension.
 2. Close Contact
 3. PCR Test – In case the child or a family member took the PCR test (regardless “close contact”).Child should remain at home, even though the test was not determined by Health/sanitation Center.)

【Early dismissal/Doctor consultation】

- If the child has fever or the symptoms described in the health check card while at school:
 - ① The child will be dismissed.
 - ② The child`s siblings will also be dismissed (considered as attendance suspension). Parents should call the sibling`s school for early dismissal procedures, in case they are attending another elementary or JHS within the school district.
 - ③ Parents should pick up the child (siblings as well) and take him/her to their preferred hospital/clinic for consultation.

Make sure to contact

- The school – In case the child or a family member took the PCR or similar test (contact school regardless of the result)
- City hall – In case school staff cannot be reached.
